### Plan for Compliance with the Listing Criteria (Tradable Share Ratio)

As of 31 December 2025, Cookpad Inc. (the “Company”) did not meet the listing criteria for the Standard Market of the Tokyo Stock Exchange. Accordingly, the Company hereby announces that it has formulated the following plan to achieve compliance with the criteria.

#### 1. Status of compliance with the listing criteria and improvement period

The Company’s compliance status with the Standard Market listing criteria as of 31 December 2025 (the reference date) is shown in the table below. Currently, the Company does not meet the tradable share ratio requirement. To meet this requirement, the Company will implement various measures aimed at achieving compliance with the listing criteria. As described below, the Company plans to cancel treasury shares at the end of March 2026 and subsequently undergo confirmation by the Tokyo Stock Exchange regarding its compliance status. Accordingly, the expected date of compliance is indicated in the “Improvement period” row in the table below.

#### 2. Basic policy for achieving compliance with the listing criteria

To deliver on its mission to “Make everyday cooking fun!” the Company provides services designed to address cooking-related challenges around the world. We recognise that maintaining and enhancing credibility in the capital markets is essential to fulfilling this mission and increasing corporate value on a sustainable basis. For this reason, we regard compliance with the listing criteria of the Standard Market as an important management priority and will continue to take steps to meet the criteria as early as possible.

### 3. Issues and measures relating to each item that does not meet the listing criteria

#### (1) Issues

The Company believes that the main reason its tradable share ratio falls short of the required standard is its holding of a certain number of treasury shares, which lowers the proportion of tradable shares relative to the total number of shares issued.

#### (2) Measures

The Company has resolved to cancel treasury shares consisting of "18,000,000 shares plus all shares acquired during the period from 1 April 2025 through 31 March 2026" as disclosed in the announcement titled "Decision on Matters Concerning Share Buyback and Cancellation of Treasury Shares" dated 27 March 2025. As a result of this measure, the total number of shares issued (the denominator in the tradable share ratio) will decrease, while the number of tradable shares (the numerator) will remain unchanged, thereby improving the tradable share ratio. Based on the current plan, assuming the cancellation of the 18,000,000 shares already approved, together with the shares acquired by the end of February 2026, the tradable share ratio after the cancellation of those treasury shares is estimated to be approximately 33.09% (approximate figure). This level is expected to exceed the listing criteria of 25% by a sufficient margin. Furthermore, shares acquired by the end of March 2026 will also be cancelled, and therefore the actual tradable share ratio is expected to exceed the above estimate. Following the cancellation of treasury shares, the Company will promptly submit the Report on the Distribution of Share Certificates, etc. and undergo confirmation by the Tokyo Stock Exchange based on the distribution status of its shares as of the reference date. If the Tokyo Stock Exchange confirms that the Company meets the listing criteria, the Company will promptly disclose that fact.
